

Full Moon Tango at the Acropolis Museum

The Acropolis Museum will celebrate August Full Moon on **Tuesday 1st August 2023** with the music and dance event “Tango Acropolis” in the Museum’s entrance courtyard **at 9 p.m.** The evening will start with performances by world-renowned tango dancers and a live music presentation will follow by the Orchestra “Con Estilo Tango” with tributes to great musicians of the Golden Age, such as Astor Piazzola, Osvaldo Pugliese and Juan d’ Arienzo, among others. Professional and amateur tango dancers from the public will have the opportunity to dance and turn the Museum’s courtyard into a dance floor.
